

## Big Sky International, Inc. - Soul x2P tent rev. B

### **\*\* Warning \*\***

**The silicone coated fabric that we use is very popular for lightweight products, but it will burn so keep it away from heat or open flame.**

**We have enclosed a fabric swatch for a test burn... after burning a fabric swatch you need to decide to either to accept the risk of using the product with this fabric or return the unused product for full refund.**

### **Setup instructions:**

- 1) Clear the ground of any sharp objects that will damage the tent floor. Lay out the tent inner.  
(Option: stake/peg corners, staking/pegging diagonally works best rather than staking one end then staking the other end – staking the inner down first is recommended in windy conditions.)
- 2) “Hoop” each pole and insert pole tips into the aluminum fittings on each corner of the inner tent.
- 3) Lift the pole clips with REFLECTIVE webbing to where the poles cross and attach, do this BEFORE attaching the remaining pole clips... then attach each pole clip to the poles.
- 4) The fly/outer has color coded hooks that match the aluminum fittings on tent inner, i.e. RED to RED. The hooks on each corner are hooked onto the narrow section of the aluminum fitting.
- 5) Staking/pegging the tent – one stake/peg for each tent corner, and one stake/peg on each side.  
*Use 2.5mm (1/8in) gold colored cord loops on each aluminum fitting for stake/peg loops.* In windy conditions, a person may want to use the four optional reflective guy out loops. We suggest staking the guy lines at 45 degree angles to the tent. See guy line diagram on next page.

### **Moon View roof instructions:**

- 1) After tent has been setup and fly has been attached, unzip door and attach Velcro/hook&loop from fly to poles. There is one on pole seam just about the top of the top in the fly. There is reflective webbing to aid attaching at night.
- 2) After attaching two (2) Velcro/hook & loops from fly poles, zip door shut and unhook fly at door end / wide end.
- 3) Roll fly up to where Velcro/hook & loops attached fly to poles. Next to each Velcro/hook & loop there is a loop and toggle to hold rolled up fly.
- 4) Roll each side of fly and tie with loop and toggle.
- 5) Reverse above instructions to close Moon View roof.

6) **Packing instructions:**


- 1) Reverse the above instructions
- 2) We suggest rolling rather than stuffing. It results in a smaller volume. We also suggest rolling the poles and stakes up in the tent or carrying them separately.

**Caution:** Trying to “stuff” the poles and/or the stakes may result in tearing the mesh or tent.

**Notes:**

- Make sure the pole joints are fully seated, especially on the DuraLite™ composite poles to prevent the joints from splitting.
- Please careful turning the tent upside down to shake out the dirt, excess stress on the DuraLite™ composite poles can cause them to fail.
- We suggest taking the poles apart at about the center pole joint section first, folding the pole in half, then taking apart and folding the remaining sections. (This creates a more uniform tension on the shock cord.)
